**SPEECH BY PRESIDENT FERDINAND R. MARCOS JR. AT THE 200TH COMMENCEMENT
EXERCISES OF THE PHILIPPINE MERCHANT MARINE ACADEMY (PMMA)
“MADASIKLAN” CLASS 2023**

[Delivered at the Grandstand of the PMMA Complex in San Narciso, Zambales| 20 July 2023]
