**Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Bagong Pilipinas Digibox (Procurement/ Contract No. 2024-06-103-2)**

Anent to the scheduled Pre-Bid Conference to be held on **29 August 2024** for the above-cited procurement project by the Bids and Awards Committee, please be informed of the following clarifications made and the amendments on the Bidding Documents:

Clarification	Answer
Clarification to what should be included in the Secretary Certificate board resolution.	The secretary certificate must contain the name of the person who will represent the company-bidder, stating that he/she is the duly authorized representative of the corporation, partnership, cooperative or joint venture and has full authority to perform all acts necessary and desirable under the circumstances in representation of the bidder.  For Bidder who joined the previous round, update the secretary certificate to reflect the updated name of the project with a new procurement /contract number.
Clarification whether supplier who joined the previous round of the failed bidding is still required to pay the bidding document fee	No longer required.
Clarification whether to allow the extension of delivery to 45 days?	Yes, delivery schedule may be extended to 45 days.
Clarification to the payment schedule and the documents required.	Payment will be processed upon complete delivery and documentation. The document required are as follow.  1. Two (2) Original/physical copies of the technical and legal documents, and financial documents submitted and subjected to preliminary examination during bid opening; 2. Latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS); 3. Tax Clearance; 4. Audited Financial Statement; 5. SEC registration certificate or the DTI business name registration, whichever applies; and 6. Business/Mayor's permit and registration.
Clarification for suppliers with different addresses to which should be indicated in the Bidding Document?	The supplier may indicate both addresses using a (/) to distinct the different address. However, it is required to include the address where the principal operation of business is held and where the documents and equipment to be evaluated is housed during ocular inspection

Pursuant to Section 22.5 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, this Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued for the information and guidance of all prospective bidders and shall form an integral part of the Bidding Documents issued for said the project.
