**SPEECH BY PRESIDENT FERDINAND R. MARCOS JR. AT THE OATH-TAKING
CEREMONY OF THE NEWLY PROMOTED GENERALS AND FLAG OFFICERS OF THE
ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES (AFP) AND FOREIGN PRE-COMMISSION
TRAINING INSTITUTIONS (FPCTI) GRADUATES**
